RESIDENTIAL SERVICES:

Respite services are provided to children and adults with disabilities that reside at home. Funding is under the Home and Community Based Waiver Program. Services are provided to a person in their home while the family needs time away.

These services were designed to support and provide skills and activities for daily living to adults and children with disabilities. We want to support people to become as independent as possible by giving them the skills and knowledge they need.

WORK SERVICES:

Vocational services are designed to provide paid, meaningful work for people with disabilities. Each person served in the work service program develops a sense of pride and self-worth along with learning to work with others and produce quality work. Our recycling program provides sustainable work and a way to give back to the world in which we live.

LINKS:

This new service offers individuals with developmental disabilities, brain injury, or chronic mental illness an environment where one can receive assistance with acquisition, retention, improvement in self-help, socialization and adaptive skills. Our unique environment fosters community integration and builds around technology and its use in our everyday living.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- *Funded by an outside source (arranged by your case manager or private pay)*
- *Follow safety rules of Crossroads*
- *Designed to support individuals 16 years of age or older (some exceptions may apply)*
- *Must not be harmful to others*
- *Must have a diagnosed disability*
- *Can not be a current user of alcohol or drugs*

PRE-ENROLLMENT:

- *Completed application of services*
- *Photo Identification*
- *Social Security Card*
- *Medical Reports*
- *Diagnostic Evaluations*
- *Emergency Release Forms*
- *Social History*

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from the facility will need to be arranged by the individual's parent/guardian.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- *Cost of dinner and community outings will be incurred by the individual.*
- *One week notice is required to ensure proper client to staff ratio.*
